A C.I.C. is designed for social enterprises that want to use their profits and assets for the public good. C.I.C's are limited companies or public limited companies with all the flexibility and certainty of the company form, but with some special features to ensure they are working for the benefit of the community rather than rewarding owners and investors in the company.
